

AKAI RESTAURANT LOUNGE CLUB COOKIES POLICY

As part of the management of the online Site <https://www.akaibrussels.com>, AKAI RESTAURANT LOUNGE CLUB may use cookies and process information about you.

1 DEFINITION

Cookies are small text files that are placed on the User's Terminal when consulting and browsing the Site (computer, tablet, smartphone, any device connected to the Internet). They do not enable the User to be identified and are managed by the User's Internet browser.

The term "cookie" refers to various technologies (tag, pixel, SDK, etc.) which enable information to be deposited or read on your Terminal during your browsing. The use of these technologies requires your information and, for certain purposes, your consent.

The purpose of this cookie management policy is to inform you and enable you to make an informed choice.

2 - CONSENT

In order to manage the placement of cookies on our site and, if necessary, to change your initial choice, you can manage the parameters for the use of cookies on the site. You are free to change your initial choice at any time. Your consent is valid for 6 months.

3 - OBJECTIVES

Users are informed that when they visit the Site, five main categories of cookies may be installed on their browser, in particular for the following reasons:

1. Cookies strictly necessary to use the Site

These cookies ensure the normal operation of our Website and as such cannot be deactivated. They enable basic functions to be used, such as displaying content, storing shopping baskets or securing access to logged-in areas ("Login/My Account"). They do not require express consent.

However, these cookies can be blocked by your browser settings (see "How do I accept/refuse the use of cookies?"). This may affect the operation of the site or some of its functions.

The main purposes of these cookies are :

- The preservation of the choice expressed by the User,
- Authentication with a service, such as one designed to ensure the authentication and security of the mechanism,
- Preserve in memory the contents of a shopping basket or invoice the User for the products selected,

- The personalization of the User interface, for example, concerning the choice of language or the presentation of a service, etc.).
- Certain anonymized audience measurement data,

More specifically, these cookies enable:

- use of the Site's main functions,
- Managing your choices concerning cookies,
- memorizing the display preferences of the User's Terminal (language, display settings) according to the graphic charter, the type of Terminal and the viewing or reading software that the User uses (type of Internet browser), and taking them into account during subsequent visits by the User,
- linking the different pages consulted to ensure smooth browsing,
- user session management after identification,
- managing the contents of the user's shopping basket,
- Secure access to personal areas (customer account, projects, simulations, order history, etc.)
- to compile statistics and count the number of visits to and use of the various pages and sections of the Site (number of visits, pages viewed, users' movements around the Site, etc.) in order to improve its operation, on an anonymous basis.

The provision of these services does not require express consent.

Consent is not required for audience measurement cookies, which are strictly necessary for the operation of the Site. No personal data is processed in this context.

4.- SHELF LIFE

During your browsing on the Site, Cookies may generate or collect data, depending on your browsing or your interactions on the Site. This data is stored for a maximum of thirteen months from the time it is collected.

5. HOW DO I ACCEPT OR REFUSE THE USE OF COOKIES?

a. Browser settings

You can choose to deactivate these cookies at any time. Your browser can also be set to notify you when cookies are placed on your computer and to ask you to accept them or not. You can accept or refuse cookies on a case-by-case basis or systematically refuse them once and for all.

We remind you that the settings are likely to modify the conditions of access to services requiring the use of cookies. If the browser is configured to refuse all cookies, the user will not be able, for example, to make purchases or take advantage of the essential functions of the Site. The settings are specific to each browser.

- **Chrome™**

Open the "Tools" menu, then select "Internet Options"; click on the "Confidentiality" tab, then the "Advanced" tab and select the desired level.

Open the "Tools" menu, then select "Options"; click on the "Privacy" tab and choose the options you want.

Open the "Tools" or "Settings" menu, then select "Delete private data"; click on the "Detailed options" tab, then choose the desired options.
